Pre-Tournament Information

1. Entry Fee

The entry fee of \$250.00 is required and made payable to NEASAA. Please bring the cheque to the tournament and give it to Jen Machetchuk. **Remember that failure to pay the fee by the end of the weekend will result in your school being fined an amount equal to the entry fee** as stated in NEASAA policy.

2. Team Picture, Colors and Roster

Please send your team picture, colors and roster to Vilna School, by Tuesday, March 10th.

3. Hospitality Rooms

We are very pleased to offer our staff room and conference room as the hospitality rooms for coaches, managers, trainers, and officials. Please help yourself to food and drinks throughout the tournament.

4. Concession

Both days there will be a concession at the school in the Agora. The Agora can be used by all players to relax and consume all food or drink. We request that there be no food or drink brought into the gymnasium. Water bottles are permitted inside the gym.

5. Other Food Options

There are 2 restaurants in Vilna: Vilna Hotel on Main street and Squirley's on Highway 28 as well as D&E grocery on Main street.

Spedden (about 10 minutes east on Highway 28) has a restaurant and gas station.

Bellis gas station (about 10 minutes west on Highway 28) has sandwiches.

Vilna is also about 25 minutes from Smoky Lake with plenty of options.

6. Accommodation

Teams can stay overnight at Vilna School if needed. Please let us know in advance if you are planning on staying so we can set up mats and a classroom for you. Showers will be available.

7. Awards

The medals will be presented following the Bronze and Gold Medal games.

There will be a 3-point shooting contest (with prizes) on Saturday. Each team will be asked to choose an athlete to participate.

8. Game Ball

NOTE: Please bring your own well-marked balls for the warm-up.

9. Uniforms and Choice of Bench

The highest seed in each game shall be the home team who will wear light uniforms (if possible) and shall have choice of bench.

10. Injuries and Behaviour

Vilna School is not responsible for any injuries that may occur. **All Coaches and management are responsible for the behaviour of their players, coaching staff and spectators.**

11. Local Rules

We ask you to respect our facility and abide by the following rules:

1. All team members, officials, and spectators are asked to enter and exit through the main doors only.
2. All team members, officials, and spectators are asked to remain in the designated areas only.
3. Please ensure all shoes are clean and dry prior to entering the facility. No outdoor shoes are permitted on the gym floor.
4. Please cleanup your bench area after your game.

5. Garbage receptacles will be placed in the gym and in the change rooms. Please use them. Recycling bins are also available for all bottles and cans.
6. Please ask your team not to leave their gym bags unattended in the change room. If left in there, it is at the owner's risk. If needed, there are lockers in the change room available to use, bringing a lock would be recommended.
7. Food and drink is not allowed in the gym. Water bottles are allowed.
8. Smoking/alcohol or drugs are not allowed in the school or on school property.
9. Team members are not to bounce or pass balls in the hallways or the Agora.
10. Please discuss these rules with your team before the tournament. Coaches are responsible for the behavior of their teams throughout the tournament and therefore will be held accountable.
11. Stereos or "Blaster's" are not to be brought into the gym. We have an excellent sound system available.
12. We ask coaches and players not to wear hard-soled shoes or spiked heels as they cause damage to the floor.
13. We warmly welcome all team supporters and expect them to behave in a manner in keeping with good sportsmanship.
14. Airhorns and other mechanical noisemakers (eg. garbage can lids) will not be allowed in the gym. This is an ASAA policy.

12. Rules for the Tournament

The tournament shall follow FIBA rules. All NEASAA By-laws and Policy shall apply.
